Helpful Tip #2 Independent Third-Party Assessors

Private Career College Curriculum in Ontario must undergo an adult education and a subject matter expert assessment prior to submitting the program for approval to the Superintendent. Please note:

- The adult education assessment will focus on the design elements of the program against the core set of curriculum appendices found within the program application.
- The subject matter expert assessment will focus on the content elements of the program against the core set of curriculum appendices found within the program application.
- There are specific qualification requirements that must be met to be approved as an independent third-party assessor.

"As per subsection 23 (3) of the *Private Career Colleges Act, 2005* (the Act), approved programs offered by a PCC must provide each student with the skills and knowledge required in order to obtain employment in a prescribed vocation. Subsection 11 (2) of *Ontario Regulation 415/06* mandates, as part of the program approval process, that PCCs have their programs assessed by a third-party program assessor who has expertise in the evaluation of such programs and has been approved by the Superintendent of Private Career Colleges.
